JANUARY

Poster advertising a march organised by Sinn Féin (Britain) to commemorate the sixth anniversary of Bloody Sunday.

FEBRUARY

One of a series of posters in the 1970s calling for British withdrawal and an end to collaboration.

MARCH

Celebrating International Women's Day 1982, the poster highlights the role that women have played in the Irish struggle.

APRIL

1982 poster exposing the murderous nature of the British army's Ulster Defence Regiment (UDR).

MAY

Calling on worker solidarity with the 1981 hunger-strikers for a Day of Action on April 15th 1981.

JUNE

Wanted poster issued during the 1981 Hunger-Strike.

JULY

1970s poster showing British army thugs beating up Belfast people.

Two Irish collaborators Lieutenant Price and Special Branchman Christy Power working for the British government on Dublin streets in 1920 and in 1986.

AUGUST

Reprint of 1920 Dan Breen wanted poster

brought out in 1987 by the Irish Anti-Extradition Committee to highlight Fianna Fáil's hypocrisy on extradition.

SEPTEMBER

The poster which highlighted the conditions in which republican women POWs were being held in Armagh Jail in 1980.

1989 anti-censorship poster by the cartoonist Cormac.


NOVEMBER

The brutality of the British state is clearly exposed by this 1974 poster of one of a number of POWs who was viciously attacked by the British army inside Long Kesh concentration camp.


DECEMBER





● Most of the UDR's recruits came from the disbanded and discredited sectarian 'B' Specials


● 250 UDR men have been convicted of the most heinous crimes, ranging from murder to vicious assault, attempted murder, rape, robbery and theft

● The most notorious example being the massacre of the Miami Showband in which an entire UDR patrol took part

● One of the 'Shankill butchers' was a serving UDR member

● No.5 UDR in South Derry have been responsible for the assassination of at least six Catholics, some twenty robberies, and the theft of the Magherafelt UDR arsenal in 1975

● Former UDR commandant Brigadier David Millar once said that if he sacked members just because they belonged to a loyalist paramilitary group then he would be left without a regiment






