

# SUPPORT SINN FÉIN



SINN FÉIN, founded in 1905, is the oldest political party in Ireland and the only one with an organised base throughout the thirty-two counties.

Sinn Féin's aim is the establishment of a democratic socialist republic based on the Proclamation of 1916 and the programme of the First Dáil Éireann.

Sinn Féin supports and defends the right of the Irish people to achieve self-determination and freedom by the use of arms. History shows that armed struggle has been and is the only means to overthrow British rule in Ireland.

Sinn Féin rejects all partitionist parliaments or assemblies. Our objective is an all-Ireland parliament, the successor to the First and Second Dáil.

Sinn Féin has a total of 35 elected representatives both North and South of the border.

Sinn Féin today is the same organisation as that founded in 1905 and which, in 1918, formed the First Dáil.
