

Stop Extradition Campaign

As part of the continuing policy of appeasement to the dictates of the British Government, the Free State establishment are determined to step up their policy of extraditing Republicans into the hands of R.U.C. torturers in the 6-Counties.

Seamus Shannon and Dominic McGlinchey have already fallen victim to this act of treachery and the fate of two other young men hangs on the decision of appeal courts.

These two men, Robert Russell from the 6-Counties and Paddy McIntyre from Letterkenny, Co. Donegal, are wanted by the R.U.C. because they managed to escape from the torture cells of Long Kesh in 1983. Even a scant knowledge of the operation of British 'justice' in Free State courts, should be enough to convince anyone of what little hope there is for Paddy McIntyre and Robert Russell.
