Teggart (an elderly man), John Laverty, a young man who only wanted to live in peace and look after the welfare of his family, another man was found murdered in Moyard in mysterious circumstances, many other civilians including a twelve year old boy, were badly wounded. These foul derds were carried out by the 2nd. Paras., the cream of England; seems to me that the cream has turned sour and perhaps the curdle will eventually stick in their throats and choke them.

In the early hours of Wednesday morning they decided to move in and finish off their dirty work of murder. With faces blackened they tried to creep in but the alarm was raised and battle joined.
