# CORRUPT COURTS

The survey of the "Northern Ireland" judicial system which was carried out by two N.I. University lecturers should expose once and for all the blatent bias of the Orange Courts.

The lecturers, Paddy Hillyard and Tom Hadden, put two years of work into the document; "JUSTICE IN NORTHERN IRELAND....A STUDY IN SOCIAL CONTIDENCE" Tom Hadden is a lecturer in law at Queens, he is also joint editor of the liberal Unionist publication, FOHTNIGHT. so he can't be accused of Republican propagation.

The report shows how the judicial system in the six occupied Counties is weighed heavily against the Catholic population.

ligures from the Belfast City Commission survey of 1973, which covers more than 1250 counts against over 300 defendants, found extreme discrimination

59% of defendants identified as Protestants were granted bail compared with only 27% of those identified as Protestants.

in the granting of bail.

The secterian nature of the R. U. C. is highlighted by the figures detailing charges brought against people caught with firearms.

36% of Protestants caught with firearms in searches of motor vehicles were charged with the less serious offence of "having a firearm without a certificate" compared to only 15% of Catholics.

40% of Protestants found with a gun on them were charged with "possession" as against 12% of Catholics.

The authors forward the view that Catholics are more likely to carry arms for offensive purposes while Protestants carry them for their own protection.

A look at the number of assassinations carried out by Loyalist murder groups will discredit that assertion.

The survey also points out that judges give bigger sentences to Catholics than to Protestants charged with similar offences.

No one could seriously argue with this accusation.

Some sentences handed out this year alone have been inhuman.

SEVEN YEARS for being a member of the IRA. A £50 FINE for being a member of the UVF TEN YEARS for having a gun (A Republican) SIX MONTHS for having a small arsenal (A Loyalist)

One disgusting aspect of the corrupt.

system in force in the six-Counties is
the frequent arrest and internment of
Catholics found "not guilty" by a judge
and jury.

The Tory Government defend internment by claiming that if it was possible to bring Republicans before a normal court there would be no need for internment without trial.

Yet when men are found "not guilty" by a so called "normal court" they are rearrested by Special Branch pigs and interned in Long Kesh Concentration Camp.

The National Council for Civil Liberties said that the report by Hillyard and Hadden provides strong support for abolishing sectorian discrimination in judicial systems.

We believe that the only real solution to the abuse of the judicial system in occupied Ulster is the complete abolition of the puppet state. While British imperialism maintains its stranglehold on part of Ireland there can never be justice, in or out of court.

"JUSTICE IN NORTHERN TRELAND A DECLY IN SOCIAL CONSCIENCE" adds to the growing volumes which are a damning indictment of British gunboat policies in this sector of Ireland.
Only the establishment of a Socialist Republic can guarantee a future based on

### DEATHS

The recent surfeit of political news journalists who have been chasing the unreported military caculties story. For some time the Provisional IRA has been insisting that the British army is now admitting only a small proportion of the casulties it is suffering. Alone, such suggestions might be dismissed as simple propaganda, but there are increasing reports from medical staffs and eyewitnesses which give credibility to the Provo claim.

One journalist with an English "Quality" newspaper has established, from non-attributable Army sources, that five soldiers were killed in a land mine explosion which the army claimed k lled only three.

Another British journalist has tracked down the family of one soldier who died in Northern Ireland, and whose parents were not told the reason nor the place of his death "for security reasons". Several other points have emerge . Recently, the body of a male patient, admitted in the early hours of the morning to Ward 18 of Belfast's R.V.H. was removed by military medics to the morgue at Musgrave Pk. Military Hospital ...which is a highly restricted area even for soldiers. The Provos claim to have made 14 attacks with fragmentation grenades on British troops in the last 2 months. They claim positively confir med hits in ten cases...yet only once has the press been tols about an attack, and then it was described as a much less lethal "blast bomb". If indeed Provo successes are being covered up for security reasons it will not be the first time this has happened.

# SWOOP

What was the reason for the "big swooop" which grabbed the headlines on Wednesday? TOP PROVOS HEID! was the predictable headline, based on British press hand outs.

Most of the men held were living at home, Jimmy Drumm has a sentry box facing his home at Glassmullin Gdns. Every day he entered and left his house under the watchfull eye of a sentry.

His bedroom window is on a level with the box and soldiers on duty regularly

waved to Jimmy.

It is believed that Mr. Drumm is the "Brigade Staff" Provo referred to by the imperialist media. This is utterly ridiculous, Jimmy has lived at home since his release from Long Kesh earlier this year.

He has been stopped and "screened" on numerous occasions by British patrols in the Andersonstown area.

Information we have recieved has led us to believe that most of the men "lifted" were political activists and had no connection with Oglaigh na hEireann. With the annual Sinn Fein Ard Fheis only days away it seems probable that the "swoop" was designed to aid Free State Special Branch pigs in their drive against Republicanism in the South.

### BAKER

The harrowing confessions of Albert Baker, the Loyalist assassin, shows how deep the Ulster Defence Association is involved in the sectorian murders which have been increasing over the past year.

# SHOTS

On Thursday night, about 11.00 p.m., five shots were fired at a foot patrol near the entrance to the Green Briar (on the Glen Road)

The shots seemed to be fired from an S.L.R., people coming from the Green Briar were stopped and asked were they thought the firing had come from. One soldier shouted to his companion "The ---- must have had night-sights on" (The area around the upper Glen is pitch black at night)

Speculation is mounting on the whereabouts of the missing Fusilier who killed the UDR man. It is believed that the swoop on Wednesday was directly linked with the missing soldier.

This week's ANDERSONSTOWN NEWS speculates that the soldier is now with the Irish Republican Army.

### CLAIMS

The sound of gunfire is heard nightly in the Andersonstown area, as the Brits complete their evacuation of Casement Pk. the Provo guerrillas step up their campaign.

Sources close to the Provisional's First Battalion are claiming that four soldiers from the 2nd Fusiliers have been killed and over twenty inj red since the arrival of the regiment in "Wounded Knee" (Andersonstown)

N.L.F. contacts in the area claim that one member of the lusiliers was killed by an Official 2nd Battalion Active Service Unit in retaliation for harrassment of Republican Club members.

All in all the Fusiliers have taken a pounding, the Provo guerrillas are known to be jubiliant with the success of their A.S.U.'s.

The whole Falls Road is covered with posters telling the world that "IT IS COMING" rumours have been going around about IT! Some say IT is the Commander of the Devon and Dorsets regiment; others say that IT is Jim Sullivan who plans to come up the road on a white donkey while worshippers throw palm leaves at his feet.
