PRICE SISTERS

Many people will, no doubt, have assumed that the front page of the VOLUNTEER will have followed the example of the national and international press by analysing the new Tory Assembley. We consider the case of the Price sisters and their comrades in English jails to be infinitely more important that the fact that Paddy Devlin will be earning £150 a week.

Dolores and Marian Price are rotting in a mens' high security prison somewhere in England. The two Andersonstown girls and their comrades are undergoing the worst type of mental and physical strain imaginable.

Both girls were subjected to inhuman treatment during their interrogation at the hands of English pigs from Scotland Yard's Special Investigation Branch. They were stripped naked, forcibley fingerprinted, refused access to a tolophono, denied a solicitor, questioned for four days during which they got no sleep.

When they finally made the courtroom at Winchester they were subjected to the most despicable barrage of venomous press by the English dailies.

Most of the British media condemned the Irish group before the jury had been sworn in. The poison press had a decisive effect on the "twelve honest men".

Since their conviction the Irish group have been virtually exiled. Their families have been refused news on the condition of the prisoners.

Many people in the Anderschstown area knew Dolores and Marian well. They were familiar figures at demonstrations against repression in Ireland.
Dolores in particular had a promising future ahead of her. Her love of children and her natural aptitude for making friends with everyone she met assured her of a prominent place in the teaching profession.

Like many people in the Falls/Andersonstown area Dolores didint hesitate when volunteers were called for to look

after the hundreds of families who streamed into the area after the 1969

Dolores could be found most nights in the schools and church halls consoling weeping women and children.

The events of 1969 convinced Dolores that British rule in Ireland could not be reformed, she looked for an alternative. The programme which the Republican movement proposed, regional covernment within a socialist Republic, appealed to Dolores. She dedicated most of her spare time to furthering the republican cause, many young people from the Andersonstown area can remember Dolores: impromptu lectures on political education.

Her younger sister Marion was an equally dedicated and intelligent girl, she followed the example of her sister and father by joining the Republican movement and embracing socialism.


While Gerry Fitt and his crew of political gangsters were grinning alongside Brian Faulkner, the architect of repression in Northern Ireland, the Price girls and their compatriots were beginning a life sentence in English bigh-security jails.

We in the Republican movement dedicate ourselves to helping the Irish prisoners in England and Scotland to gain political status and the right to return to their own country pending their release.

The dream of Dolores and Marian was to see the imperialist structure in Ireland smashed, North and South. Imperialism has taken a new face with the implimentation of the Tory Assembley plan. British rule in Ireland must be smashed, whether it is represented by Brian Faulkner.

GEORGE JACKSON

When George Jackson was 18 he was given a sentence of one year to life for stealing 70 dollars from a petrol station. He was to spend over ten years in various Amer spend over ten years in various American prisons. In 1970 the 28 year old Jackson was charged with the murder of a screw in the death Soledad Prison and faced the 7th, sentence if convicted. On Aug. days after he was transferred to the notorious San quentin. While in custody here his young brother Jon, just 17 year old, invaded the San Rafael courthouse singlehanded. Jon was armed with a satchel full of handguns, an assault rifle, ans a shotgun which he had hidden under his raincoat. Jon and three

black convicts he had armed left the courthouse with five hostages, as they left the main court Jon shouted "Free the Soledad Brothers by 12.30".... a few minutes later Jon was dead.

A year later George Jackson was murdered in the course of a prison riot, his writings are a lasting memorial to the lad who was killed by the system, the same system that the Provisional guerrillas are fighting to smash in Ireland. The same system that holds large sections of the Earth in bondage. Only the colour of George's skin distinguished him from the freedom fighters in Ireland, men who rose from the ghettos in 1969, determined to resist imperialism with everything in their power, over 100 of them were, like George Jackson, to become legends in their time.

Some of Jackson's writings sound uncannily like the writings of James Connolly:
"The slaver was and is the factory owner, the businessman of capitalist Amerika, the man responsible for employment, wages, prices, control of the nation's institutions and culture. It was the capitalist infrastructure of Europe and the U.S. which was responsible for the rape of Africa and Asia. Capitalism murdered those 30 million in the Congo. Believe me, the European and Anglo-Amerikan capitalist would never have wasted the ball and powder were it not for the profit principle".

Jackson, speaking of the revolution, spoke in terms that showed his understanding of situations like Ireland, his view is shared by the Provisional revolutionaries:

"One does'nt wait for all conditions to be right to start the revolution, the forces of the revolution itself will make the conditions right". Che Guevara may have said something similar before Jackson, either way, the armchair revolutionaries of the Officials should take note. If they wait for the "proper conditions" (i.e. the union of the Catholic and Protestant working class in joint action against imperialism in Ireland) then the "revolution" as envisaged by the Officials should burst forth on the world some where around the year 4000.

Several Republican prisoners in Armagh Prison have asked for Jackson's books to be sent in; we wonder does his thoughts on the female revolutionary have anything to do with the request?

In a letter to Angela Davis he said: "In our last communication I made a statement about women, and their part in revolutionary culture (people's war). It was nt a clear statement. I meant to return to it but was diverted. I understand exactly what the woman's role should be. The very same as the man's. Intellectually, there is very little difference between male and female. The differences we see in bourgeois society are all conditioned and artificial".

Jackson is gone but his spirit lives in the form of his writings, in several years time the writings of many imprisoned Irish revolutionaries will no doubt be documented sent to all parts of the world were oppression exists. Freedom F ghters in many countries will debate the thoughts of the Irish revolutionaries during the struggle for liberation in this island.

TWOMEY TALKS

Last week Seamus Twomey gave his first interview since his incredable escape from Mountjoy Prison. He spoke at length to Boerries Gallasch, editor of the German magazine DER SPIEGEL:

YOUR HELICOPTER ESCAPE FROM MOUNTJOY IS
THE TALK OF IRELAND AND ALSO OF BRITAIN
AND THE CONTINENT. EVEN PEOPLE WHO DON'T
THINK MUCH OF THE IRA MAKE JOKES ABOUT
THE "ESCAPE OF THE CENTURY". IT IS SAID THAT YOU ARE THE ONLY ONE WHO KNEW ABOUT
THE ESCAPE BEFOREHAND.

Twomey: That's not right. Kevin Mallon and Joe O'Hagan who escaped with me knew about it. Also the other Republican prisoners knew, so that they were able to help us in the decisive moment and if unexpected difficulties should come up.

FOR HOW LONG HAD YOU PREPARED FOR THE COUP?

Exactly five weeks.

DID YOU EVER FLY IN A HELICOPTER BEFORE?

I remember the only other helicopter trip. It was in July of 1972 when I travelled aboard an RAF helicopter on the invitation of her British Majesty...
...in order to visit Mr. Whitelaw in England for a discussion of the Northern Ireland problem.

THOSE WERE THE GOOD OLD DAYS OF THE IRS. TODAY, HARDLY ANY LEADING POLITICIAN LIKE WHITELAW WOULD NEGOTIATE WITH YOU.

That's right...for two reasons. Number 1: He is not allowed to any longer. I have called Whitelaw a liar during an interview with Der Spiegal and the same thing happened again shortly afterwards. When he was asked by Enoch Powell in the British Parliament to produce the ceasefire agreement signed by him he told his own parliament a lie.

HE DENTED EVER HAVING SIGNED SUCH A DOCUMENT?

But he did sign it. And the M.P.'s knew it. But they let him get away with it that time. He only had to promise that he would never talk to us again. That is the reason why Whitelaw is now a political nobody.

He made them wrestle away from him the word "never"...the only word a politician should not use if he intends to remain a credible pardner for negotiation. He stood with his back to the wall. He was allowed to continue "on probation". But he is not allowed any longer to really negotiate.

PERHAPS THE BRITISH ARE NOT FORCED ANY LONGER TO NEGOTIATE WITH YOU. THE NUMBER OF IRA ACTIONS HAS REDUCED CONSIDERABLY. THERE IS A POLITICAL SOLUTION IN SIGHT...

.... IS THE I.R.A. BEATEN?

Beaten? Beaten? How can a people's army, a guerrilla organisation, ever be beaten? It is true that the nature of our actions has changed. The car bomb alone is not sufficent any longer. And regular reports about British soldiers being killed, so far almost 200, are wearing thin.

ARE THESE NOT JUST EXCUSES? DO THEY NOT HIDE THAT THE I.R.A. IS SEVERELY INJURED? THAT THEY HAVE FEW WEAPONS LEFT?

No! We still get weapons. But every war also has a psychological side. We must be careful that the people don't get used to a certain degree of war. We increase the fear of war...then, if and when we think it's right we reduce it for the same reason.

AND YET IT'S UNDENIABLE THAT OVER 1'500 IRA FIGHTERS ARE INTERNED IN NORTHERN AND SOUTHERN IRELAND, THAT TIME AND AGAIN ARMS CACHES ARE FOUND.

As far as the intermed are concerned, a great portion are simply upright Republicans, patriots, but not members of cur fighting units. Sure, I admit our medium units, the structure of our army, at a N.C.O. level, was severely affected at the beginning of the year.

BECAUSE THE MORALE OF THE TROOPS HAD BEEN AFFECTED?

Because the Brits had succeeded in forcing information from some of them by torture, and because they bought up informants. But that is over, since we, for instance in Derry caught two informers...it is quiet there, not one case of treason... not a single one.

WHAT DID YOU DO TO THEM?

They were given a death sentence by IRA courts and shot dead. This fact was made public by the IRA.

HOW WERE YOU ABLE TO DETERMINE THAT THESE PEOPLE HAD ACTUALLY SPIED?

We have improved our counter-espionage. We do that centrally now, not any longer non the level of individual units. By the way, Der Spiegel has written a lot about the Claudia affair. The arms transport with this German frieghter from Libya to Ireland was also betrayed. We have proof and therefore have handed down two death sentences.
