All Volunteers who took part in the unofficial operation of 2/I2/'58 at the Curragh Concentration Camp dismissed themselves from the Army, (General Order No. 5(2)). They are at liberty to apply to the Army Council for re-admission to the Army.

Such applications should be forwarded to G.H.Q. through the O/C Republican Prisoners at the Camp. This communication and the

accompanying statement will be read to all prisoners.

Footnote: (a) The matter of the men concerned parading with the general body did not arise at the Army Council meeting, but my personal direction is that that provided they are prepared to take instructions from you, and if they themselves so wish, they may do so.
