## ARDOYNE COMMUNITY FACES TWO MORE LOYALIST MARCHES IN AUGUST

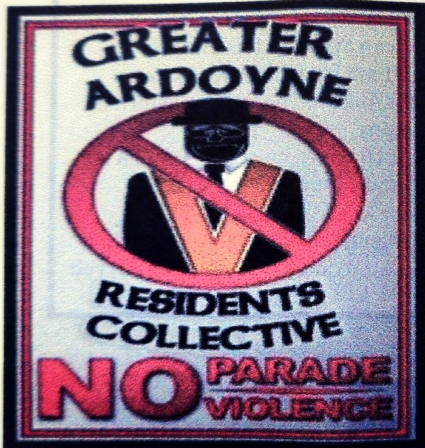
The Irish Republican Socialist Party in North Belfast are continuing to call for two further offensive and sectarian loyalist marches through Ardoyne in August to be rerouted.

### LAGAN VALLEY A&E GOES PART TIME

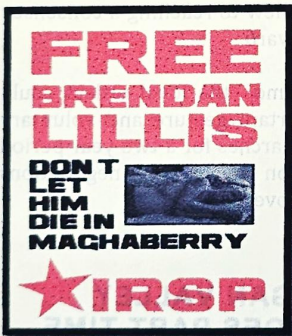

## **BRENDAN LILLIS UPDATE**

As we go to print Justice minister David Ford is still refusing to release dying republican prisoner Brendan Lillis from Maghaberry. This week, Dr. O'Domhnaill from the Irish UN association visited Brendan in Maghaberry, he said "I believe he will die in Maghaberry prison because he is suffering from an advanced form of a condition which requires specialist attention for a prolong period." Roisin Lynch, Brendan's partner met with David Ford this week and remains frustrated and angry at his intransigence. Roisin said, that Ford had given her the run-around again and that she found the meeting sad and depressing. I fear now that David Ford will not release Brendan until he is either dead or only a matter of hours from death, she said. "I did not detect any compassion or justice from the justice minister today."
