



NICKY KELLY is a prisoner in Portlaoise Jail serving a 12 year sentence for a crime he did not commit - the Sallins Mail Train robbery in 1976. In Oct. '82 the Supreme Court refused his final appeal and his only option now is to demand his release by the Minister of Justice. Nicky was convicted on the basis of a concocted statement which he was forced to sign after prolonged "in depth" interrogation. Allegations of police illtreatment dominated the trial. The IRA claimed the robbery and later his two co-defendants were released on Appeal. Amnesty International, the ICCL and several international human rights groups expressed concern about the case. Many organisations and prominent individuals have called for his release.
