INISHOWEN

The aims and objects of Sinn Fein is the complete overthrow of British rule in Ireland and to establish a 32-County democratic Socialist Republic based on the Proclamation of 1916. Sinn Fein proposed government structures for all Ireland would be in keeping with the principle of democratic decentralisation and has four elected levels.

- (1) *Community Peoples' Councils.*
- (2) *District Councils.*
- (3) *Regional Councils.*
- (4) *A National Parliament.*

The above four tier system would mean that Ireland would be one large island community, a national community government which would mean more devolved power to the people.

What would this mean to Inishowen? For example, Bunrana and District would be one community council with people elected for urban and rural.

Carndonagh would incorporate urban and rural.

Moville would incorporate urban and rural.

Clonmany and Ballyliffen would be one community council.

Newtowncunningham, Carrigans, Burt, Bridgend, Burnfoot could be an amalgamation of community councils.

Inishowen district government with government offices and departments in Inishowen would mean real power devolved to the people.

Inishowen would consist of five community councils: Bunrana and District, Carndonagh and District, Moville and District, Clonmany and District, Bridgen or Newtown District. An Inishowen government would have power to deal with all administrative matters and provide for the peoples needs at local level

Since I was elected I have campaigned for money for Water, Sewerage, Houses, Roads Harbours, Industry etc for Inishowen and will continue to do so if elected for another 5 Years. I will continue to campaign for Irelands right of Ownership of Rockhall

WATCH WHAT THEY DO, NOT WHAT THEY SAY

INISHOWEN DEVELOPMENT PLAN

A comprehensive development plan for Inishowen, also a development plan for Clonmany, involved with Carndonagh and Moville development plans.

HOUSING LOANS & GRANTS

A Housing Bank to provide capital at a low interest rate to the Housing and Construction Industry. That all housing and reconstruction grants be increased to meet costs of materials. All building materials to be free of V.A.T. That 100% loans be provided to build or purchase without guarantors at a low interest rate. That a State run construction company be established and a major building programme implemented. That houses be provided in local areas for local people. That all disability and housing aid for the elderly be 100% grant-aided. That all housing schemes be provided with full services and well planned with sufficient greenery, and landscaped accordingly, plus all the amenities for young and old.

WATER AND SEWERAGE

It is the duty of Local Government to provide areas, towns and villages with water and sewerage. Group water schemes and group sewerage schemes should be 100% grant aided.

ROADS

Investment in a good road system is essential for economic development, industry, agriculture and tourism would create useful employment, long term low interest rate loans would be the answer.

AGRICULTURE

100% grants are necessary to tackle land reclamation and drainage to make small farmers up to a viable economic holdings, affording farmers a decent standard of living. A guaranteed price for all farm produce.

FISHING

As a maritime nation we should have a 200 miles fishing zone, free from the E.E.C. and developed in the best interests of Irish fishermen and not for the benefit of E.E.C. and East European fishing fleets. Fish and food processing should be implemented.

FORESTRY

Our forestry industry is under-developed. Large areas of hill land in Inishowen could be planted and useful employment provided in planting, thinning, trimming and processing.

DEEP SEA PORT DUTY FREE INDUSTRIAL ZONE

Inishowen has great potential for industry, agriculture, fishing and tourism. The development of Lough Swilly as a deep sea port, coupled with an industrial zone in Inishowen to link up with the port, incorporated with 100% grants for people developing and processing our own nautical resources.

EMPLOYMENT

Whilst it is the policy of Sinn Fein that all our people be provided with meaningful and useful employment, nevertheless, in the interim period there is a need for proper employment exchanges in each of the following areas — Bunclrana, Carndonagh, Clonmany, Merville and Newtowncunningham. It should not be the function of the Garda Stations to be used for that purpose nor the Gardai to handle unemployment certificates.

If elected again to the Donegal County Council I will continue to work and serve the people of Inishowen in their best interests.

CAMPAIGNED AGAINST:

As a Sinn Fein candidate in the Local Government Elections of 1979 I was then elected to the Donegal County Council and Bunclrana Urban Council. Since then I was elected by the people of Bunclrana and Inishowen, my prime objective was to work for and serve in the best interests of the people. I became involved in many issues and campaigns which in my opinion and the organisation I represent, believed it was the right thing to do for the people. Here are some of the many things I campaigned against.

GAMING MACHINES & ONE ARM BANDITS

DUMPS

I opposed the siting of no less than seven landfill dumps in Inishowen, i.e., Bunclrana Town Dump, Barrmoore, Tullydish, Meendoran, Clonmany, Linsfort, Desertegney, Doireen Moor, Ballymagan, Sleadrin Glen, Ballyloskey, Carndonagh and many more which I opposed in other parts of the county including Manorcunningham.

WATER RATES

I opposed Water Rates because they are another form of taxation and voted against them in the Donegal County Council and Bunclrana Urban Council. The first anti Water Rates Committee was set up in Bunclrana and I helped to organise Committee's throughout the County

URANIUM

I opposed Uranium mining because of the political, ecological and moral dimensions, as well as being a health hazard, which would, if mining had been permitted, would have made this county a parched wilderness.

POTHOLES

I opposed the paying of Motor Tax and had a motion passed by the Donegal County Council to withhold money until Donegal be declared a pothole free zone. Malfeasance and non feasance should be abolished.

GROUND RENTS

I opposed ground rents because I do believe the Irish people should not be paying British absentee landlords for land which is rightfully theirs. I had many motions passed by the Donegal County Council and Buncrana Urban District Council about same.

E.E.C. AND N.A.T.O.

We, the Sinn Fein organisation, are opposed to the E.E.C. and N.A.T.O. for many reasons, and because it is an erosion of our sovereignty. E.E.C. membership has caused many factories and small businesses to close, putting thousands of people onto lengthy dole queues. Many small farmers and small businesses have gone bankrupt; our seas are saturated with fishing boats which are taking away our fish, processing them in our harbours by their labour and leaving behind them a mess of refuse washed up on our beaches.

We should resist N.A.T.O., with all our energy and might because N.A.T.O. would be a total disaster for Ireland.

BRITISH BORDER

We in Sinn Fein have campaigned against the maintenance and security of a British imposed un-natural border which the majority of people in Ireland do not want or wish to pay out £500 million per year to maintain, money which could be utilised for roads, housing, water, sewerage and many other essential services which we in Inishowen could do with.
