

JOIN THE ANTI-INTERMENT LEAGUE

The anti-interment league was formed in the week after the introduction of internment in the north of Ireland. The Anti-Interment League is a United Front which brings together Irish and British organisations on the two demands:

RELEASE THE INTERNEES

IMMEDIATE WITHDRAWAL OF BRITISH TROOPS FROM IRELAND.

There are 30 affiliated organisations, including those most affected by internment in the north of Ireland; Sinn Fein (Provisional); Clann na-Eirann (Official) and N.I.C.R.A..

The anti-interment League aims to mobilise political support for its demands in Britain, both from the Irish in Britain and British workers.

We have been co-ordinating propaganda work to counter the distorted views of the British press on the north of Ireland. As early as the beginning of September we highlighted the torture methods used against internees and later admitted in the Compton report. We are organising the adoption of internees and the collection of information on them.

We need the full support of those who agree with our demands. On March the 26th we are holding a mass demonstration in London. We hope to mobilise at least 50,000 people.
