Other steps (of course, in the same direction) are—

- 1. Guns and orders from England.
- 2. The raid on the house of Padraig Pearse's mother.
- 3. The arrest of the widow of Terence MacSwiney.
- 4. The firing on unarmed Republican prisoners in Mountjoy Jail.
- 5. The suppression of all Republican papers.
- 6. The killing of Cathal Brugha.

If those seven steps do not enable us to reach the Republic, England will no doubt prescribe others.
