

# THE BRITISH WITHDRAWAL FROM NORTHERN IRELAND CAMPAIGN

DEMANDS In view of the situation in Northern Ireland, we demand

- (a) that the British Government name a definite date for the complete withdrawal of British troops in the immediate future;
- (b) that the Union between Britain and Northern Ireland be ended.

We believe that these demands are a necessary basis for any peaceful solution in Northern Ireland.

NO MILITARY SOLUTION There will be no military solution to the problems of Northern Ireland. The British Army, the I.R.A.s and the protestant loyalist forces have all tried by violence and failed to make the people of Northern Ireland accept policies they do not want. The suffering of the people of northern Ireland is measured in the fear and worry of routine searches, street shootings, bombings, broken families and bombed out buildings. If the deep divisions are to be healed, it must be by the people themselves talking and working towards peace without outside domination. The improvement in living and working conditions, the sense of community, and peace itself can only be gained by protestant and catholic people uniting to take control of their lives - both where they work and where they live. The actions of the various armies are making this positive growth impossible.

ACTION To these ends, supporters of the campaign have and will continue to :

- (a) distribute leaflets to British troops, informing them of ways of leaving the army.
- (b) campaign among civilians to gain support for our demands.
- (c) produce and distribute leaflets warning potential recruits of the dangers of joining the army.
