## Men and Women of West Wicklow

Much water has passed under the bridges of our country since Theobald Wolfe Tone, Robert Emmet, Lord Edward, and Michael Dwyer sacrificed liberty and life for the ideal of a free Ireland. The Sinn Fein candidate for West Wicklow at the General Election will fight for the same ideal for which these men died—the ideal of an Ireland free from the sod to the sky. Are we, men and women of Wicklow, fallen so low that we are willing to accept for Ireland to-day any lower status than that of a Nation free amongst the Nations of the World? Sinn Fein stands for a free and independent Ireland—an Ireland as free from foreign tyranny and dictation as are the great United States of America to-day. Our policy is the policy of self-reliance and self-determination. We believe that all things right and just are obtainable, provided we seek them with sufficient energy and courage. We will set up our own Courage in Dattin. Dy staying at home we will deny England's right to govern us instead of admitting it by going to London. It is because of the presence of Irish Representatives in the Westminster Parliament that England claims the right to conscript us.

The coming election is the greatest opportunity our country has ever had of stating ler determination to secure her ancient rights. Do not let it pass, it will never recur. There can be only one kind of peace at the termination of this war: A peace the terms of which will entitle all conquered nations to decide for themselves the form of government under which they will live. At the Peace Conference Ireland must be represented by men with will seek Ireland's independence.

Election funds will be required to secure that West Wicklow shall be represented by a Sinn Fein or Free Ireland member. Will you refuse to give a few pounds for the cause for which so many Wicklow men and women have given their lives? Let every man and every woman be as generous to-day with their money as their ancestors were with their lives.
