€100 is Just the Beginning

Current plans will see a 'property tax' and domestic water tax replace the €100 home tax in 2013/2014. These new taxes will cost around €1,000 per year. That's roughly €20 per week! And it is virtually certain that there will be no widespread waivers for these taxes.
