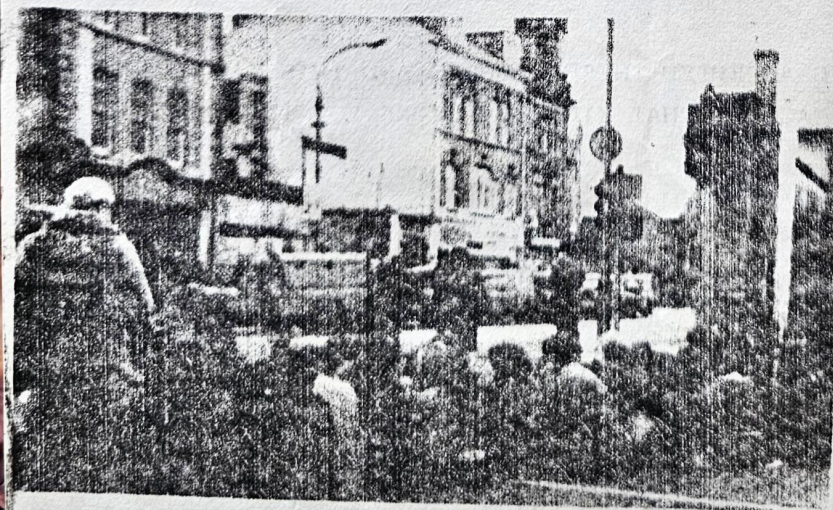

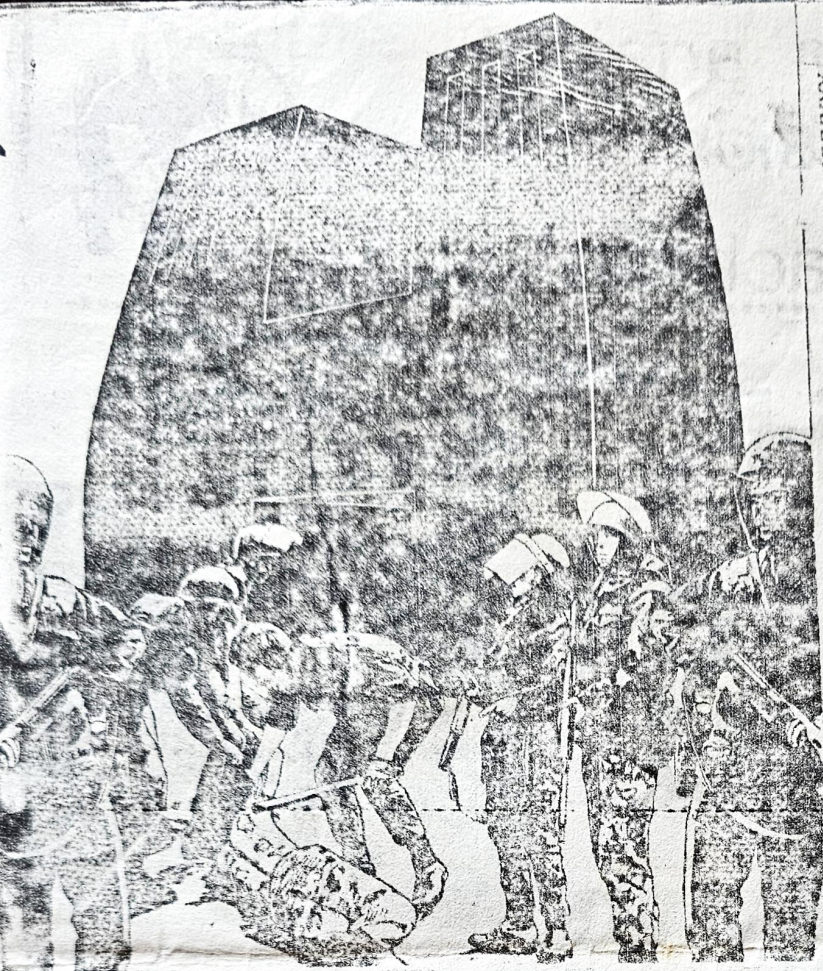

HUNGER STRIKERS' CONDITION

Bobby Sands, after 32 days on hunger strike, has lost over 24 lbs. and reports himself in high spirits but now feeling weak for the first time. His blood pressure has dropped dramatically.

Frank Hughes, who was seriously wounded and had to undergo major surgery after his capture, reports headaches and dizzy spells.

Raymond McCreesh and Patsy O'Hara, the most recent to join the hunger strike, report no ill effects yet.
