EDUCATION AND RECREATION

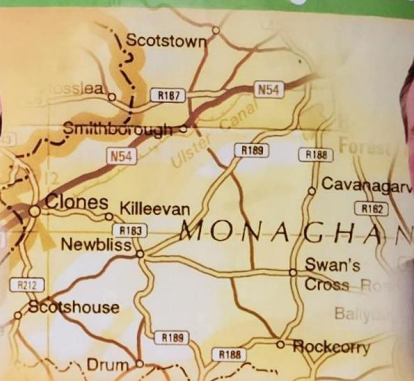
Pat and Sheila are working for:

IMPROVEMENT OF SERVICES AND INFRASTRUCTURE
