THE SITUATION AS IT STANDS . . .

Since March 1st this year several girls and men have been charged with committing acts of a political nature contrary to the laws of the British Government.

TREATED AS “CRIMINALS”

(What Merlyn has in store for our comrades).

1. They will be classed as criminals. Their actions as Political idealists will be ignored.
2. They will be forced to wear prison garb – refusal to do so can mean solitary confinement, stripped naked in a “punishment” cell for an unlimited period of time.
3. Prison work of the most soul destroying kind will be forced on them, (sewing mail bags or scrubbing floors). Again refusal will result in punishment.

PUNISHMENT (The corner stone of the Prison System)

According to the Authorities, Prisoners have no “Rights” just “Privileges”. Refusal to conform to the Regime will result in loss of privileges – i.e. visits exercise, contact with other prisoners, loss of remission.

WHAT ARE WE ASKING YOU TO DO? – PROTEST, PROTEST, PROTEST!!

Remember what a united mass movement can do – has done in the past? Get out on the streets, picket, march. Be persistent, be adamant, be convinced that your sons and daughters, our comrades, will **NEVER** be treated as common criminals, will **NEVER** have to don Prison garb, will **NEVER** spend months locked in “solitary” because he/she refused to bend the knee.

Be determined to smash this system as we smashed Stormont.
