#### Screening of Congressional Hearings on Irish Political Deportations

The Matt Morrison Defense Fund and St. Louis Irish Northern Aid will be hosting a screening of the Congressional subcommittee hearings on Irish deportees held in Washington earlier this month.

The video will be shown at 1:15 p.m. on Saturday, February 22, 1997 at the White House, 10185 Gravois in St. Louis, Mo. The presentation will be divided into three sessions. The first session comprises the questioning of the administration panel, represented by David Martin, General Counsel for the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service. The testimonies of the wives of the potential deportees follows, and the third session consists of statements from a panel of legal advisors familiar with immigration issues. During and after the screening, Francie Broderick, who testified before the committee, will be available to answer questions, as will her husband, Matt Morrison, who is under a deportation order.

The screening is open to the public, and no admission will be charged. Refreshments will be available.
