## PROTEST AT LONDON SENTENCES

Sinn Féin protests at the sentences passed in London yesterday on three Irish Republicans, James Monaghan of Dublin, Patrick Mc Garrigle of Donegal and Brendan Magill of Armagh. Their "Crime" was that they tried to help their own people in occupied Ireland. They are in a succession of various generations of Irish exiles who worked and suffered for Irish freedom, from Tom Clarke and the Fenians to the men of the 1920s, 1939 and 1955.

Sinn Féin asks the Irish people to join in the protest against the two and three-year sentences and hopes that generous support will be given to An Cumann Cabhrach which looks after the dependants of Republican prisoners.
