TONY D'ARCY, IRISH REPUBLICAN PRISONER, AFTER A HUNGER-STRIKE OF OVER 7 WEEKS, HAS DIED.

The lives of the other Republican prisoners, also on hunger-strike for over 7 weeks, are drawing to a close.

They have used this form of protest as the only one possible to obtain the age-old object—political treatment.

Not for themselves, observe, but for those of their comrades who have been degraded as common criminals.

“ Greater love no man hath ”——. Would to God that all Irishmen had their loyalty, tenacity, and courage.

“ Far dearer the grave or the prison,

TONY D'ARCY, brave Soldier of the Republic, has died.

Among the Republican prisoners dying in Irish jails on 7 weeks' hunger-strike are veterans of the National struggle for the past 30 years, some of them sentenced to death in 1916.

Where the British failed to achieve De Valera is going to succeed, and send Jack Plunkett to a felon's grave beside his martyred brother, the poet, Joseph.
