STOP EXTRADITION

Dermot Finucane, Owen Carron and Jim Clarke are the three Irish citizens facing being handed over the border to the brutality of British justice in January/February. Dermot is a younger brother of Belfast solicitor Pat Finucane who was assassinated in February 1989 by pro-British paramilitaries; Owen was election agent for Bobby Sands MP and later himself MP for Fermanagh/South Tyrone; Jim Clarke is a Donegal republican and prominent county GAA player. Dermot and Owen's lives are in danger if extradited - both have been threatened with execution by loyalists. Jim's case is similar to the Guildford Four, in that he was convicted purely on the basis of a statement drawn up by the RUC which they beat him into signing. Among those witnesses to Jim's alibi was Letterkenny doctor James McDaid, now a Fianna Fail TD. Please come along to this important meeting, and do what you can to put a stop to political extradition.
