BORN AT

1882.

Teacher of Corduff National School, prior to April, 1916; Leader of North Co. Dublin Volunteers in Rising, winning the battle of Ashbourne; sentenced to death (commuted to Penal Servitude for life); and released under Amnesty, June 1917.

Re-arrested for speech made in Co. Longford, and sentenced to one year's imprisonment. Succumbed to prison treatment and forcible feeding in Mountjoy Prison, and
